<sup>2</sup> As part of their scheduled academic progress, third-year students in the part-time program are required to complete Professional Responsibility. Professional Responsibility is also open to students in the full-time division who have completed their second year. Priority will be given to third-year part-time students.
<sup>3</sup> Externships are open to students who have successfully completed instruction equivalent to 28 credit hours toward the J.D. degree, are in good academic standing, and have a grade point average of at least a 2.00. Subject to securing a placement, eligible students may enroll in two to six (2-6) credits in the Summer Semester. Maximum of 12 externship credits may be earned in externship placements.
